North Central Texas College (NCTC) is a two-year institution primarily serving residents of Cooke, Denton, and Montague counties, as well as Graham ISD, by offering technical and academic courses for certification or associate degrees, along with continuing and community education.

NCTC Mission Statement:

North Central Texas College is dedicated to student success through institutional excellence.

After experiencing record enrollment in Fall 2017 (10,488), enrollment has declined 28% over the past four years. The COVID pandemic contributed to serious erosion of student enrollment during 2022 through 2022. It will take years for community colleges such as NCTC to recover. Current expectations, however, are that enrollment will soon resume an upward trend due to one of the counties in the NCTC service area (Denton County) holding the distinction of being one of the fastest-growing counties in the state.

The institution faces several challenges, one of which is the critical need to upgrade our technology to enable us to teach competitively and with relevance to the systems already in use in the workplace in which our students must function. The college made great strides with technology using federal funds (HEERF) during the past two years. But the costs for providing the underlying technology infrastructure district-wide have been astronomical and will continue to represent a substantial financial burden on the college. Additionally, the institution must continue to dedicate significant resources to improve and expand technology for security and safety measures across the District.

The second, and undoubtedly most significant challenge, is the insufficient tax base for the College to support such a large, populous service area. The tax base for NCTC consists of one county that is rural and agricultural, in nature; maintenance and operations tax revenue represents only 4.4% of budgeted revenue. The state funding used to help pay instructional costs has decreased more than half, as a percent of budgeted revenue, from 52.5% in 1994 to 24.1% for 2022. The Board of Regents has increased tuition and fees over the years and that revenue now represents 48.8% of budgeted revenue.

The North Central Texas College District respectfully supports the \$2.03 billion formula funding request submitted by the Texas Association of Community Colleges (TACC) in its letter to the Legislative Budget Board and the Governor's Office, Budget Division. State support remains critical to the district as it continues to fulfill its statutory role and mission to offer vocational, technical, and academic courses for certificate, transfer, and degree programs. Together with Texas' other 49 community college districts, we will continue to do much of the heavy lifting in the state's efforts to achieve the 'Building a Talent Strong Texas' strategic plan. Expanded state investments in community colleges will support dual credit courses that give high school students an early start in postsecondary education; initiatives to recruit uncredentialed Texans and support them through graduation; and the creation and expansion of programs built on the skills necessary for gainful employment and Texas' continued economic growth.

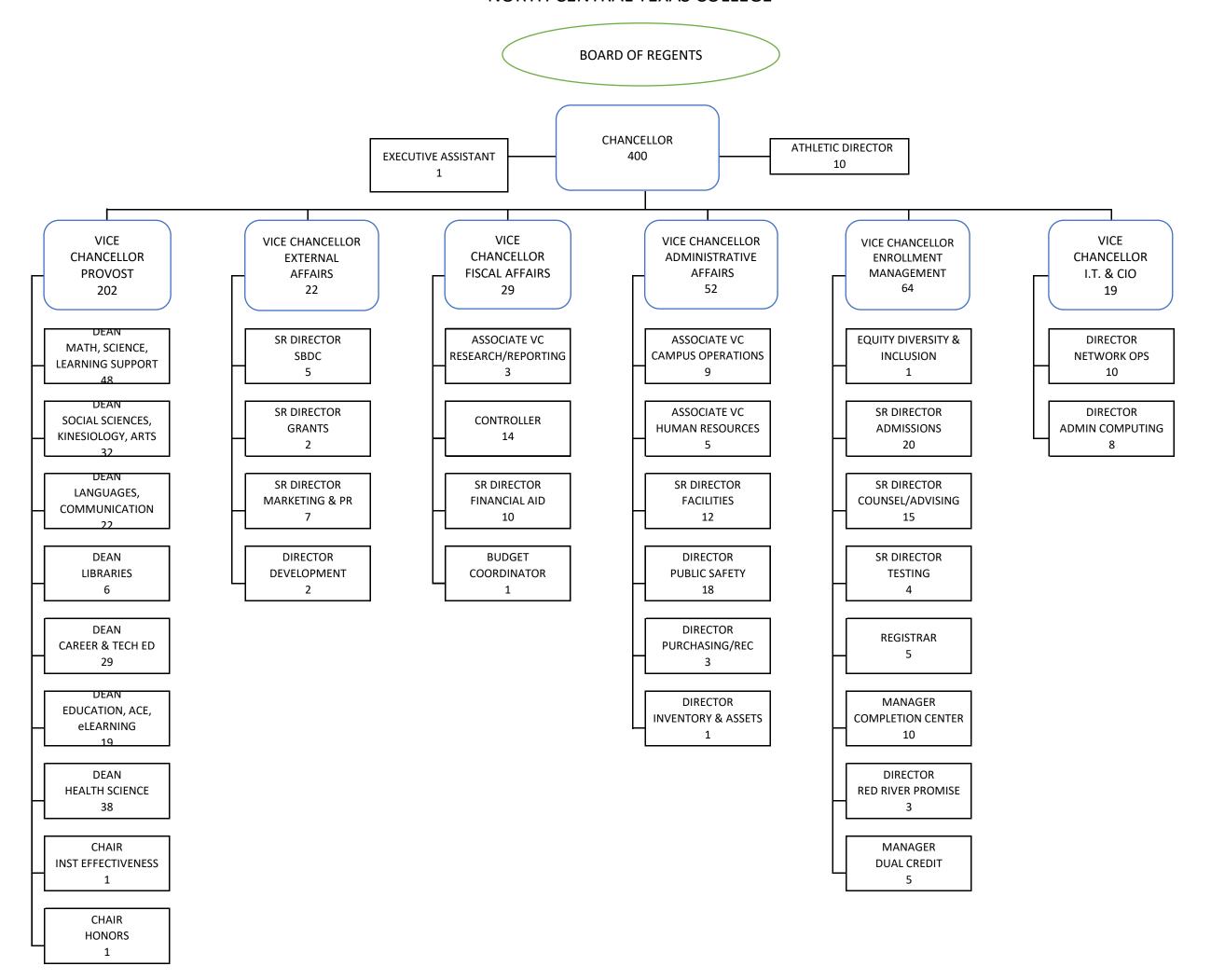
