Vaccination requirement applies to anyone under the age of 22 years as follows:

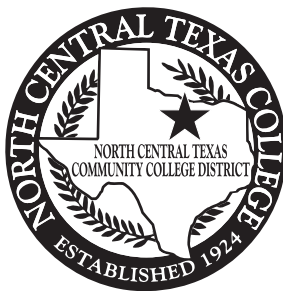
- All first-time freshmen
